

Minutes:

J. Eliasz welcomes all participants to the 2nd MC Meeting in 2016. H. Höritsch informs on Nina Britt Husebo's absence due to other obligations.

1. Programme and Agenda

D. Simion will attend RINCK Convention related topics (agenda point 5).

2. MC Minutes 02/2016

The minutes are approved without any comments.

3. Various minutes (MC related topics)

J. Eliasz reports on the EXEC Meeting dated 16 March 2016 in Bordeaux / FRA. All motions by the MC (SMART programmes with ALB, AND, MLT, EHF Working Group for "Wheelchair Handball", EU Week of Sports) were accepted by the EXEC.

Further attention shall be paid to the minutes of the 2016 EHF Secretaries General Conference in Dubrovnik, especially regarding inputs by the National Federations concerning grassroots activities.

4. Methods & Coaching**4.1. 2016 Analysis EHF Men's EURO / POL**

The quantitative (Swiss Timing) and qualitative analysis (P. Kovacs) were received and published via the activities-website.

4.2. 2016 Analyses EHF YAC EUROs M18 CRO and M20 DEN

The responsible persons for the qualitative analysis of the M18 / CRO and M20 / DEN shall be nominated by the respective National Federations. The National Federations will be contacted accordingly.

4.3. 2016 Analyses EHF YAC Championships M18 BUL, M18 GEO, M18 LTU

The organisers of the M18 BUL, M18 CRO and M18 LTU will be contacted in order to nominate a National Handball Expert realising the qualitative analysis. The catalogue of criteria will be provided to the National Federations. In general the analyses shall be provided within 30 days after the Championships.

5. Education and Training**5.1. RINCK Convention Status**

D. Simion reports on the current status of the RINCK Convention. BUL and LTU have not provided the annual activity report. The respective National Federations will be approached again in order to provide the annual report.

ISR: The requested detailed information was provided by ISR. The EHF MC therefore confirms the RINCK Convention Level 3 for ISR.

A basic and short questionnaire on the education system for coaches shall be sent to the non-signatories ALB, AND, ARM, AZE, BIH, FAR, GEO, KOS, LIE, MDA, MON and UKR. In addition selected academic EHF Lecturers (RINCK Convention panel) shall support the non-signatories by adapting their national system to fulfil the RINCK Convention requirements. Respective requests have already been received from BIH and KOS.

5.2. National Master Coach Courses SRB / ESP-POR / GER

Currently national Master Coach Courses are organised in SRB and GER and are supported by the EHF with EHF Lecturer nominations (SRB: P. Landure / FRA – EHF Lecturer and M. Sibila / SLO – EHF Lecturer; GER: R. Brack / GER and P. Landure / FRA – EHF Lecturer).

P. Sequeira (being the new responsible person for coaching education in POR) informs on the current situation regarding the 2nd and 3rd module of the combined National Master Coach course in ESP / POR (combined with e-learning platform).

5.3. EHF Coaches Licensing in EHF Competitions as of 2015/16

B. Kozłowska informs on the future procedure (starting with next season) in case of violation of the regulations (e.g. not providing documents despite various reminders): If a club / National Federation fails to provide the necessary documents despite various reminders a final reminder will be sent by the Legal Department. In case the documents are still not provided a legal case will be opened. The final decision (e.g. penalties) will be made by the EHF Legal Bodies.

5.4. 2016 Young Coaches Workshop / HUN – Preview

7 male and 7 female participants from (BUL, DEN, EST, FAR, GBR, HUN, ISR, ITA, NED, NOR, RUS, SCO, SLO and SWE) will attend the 3rd edition of the Young Coaches Workshop held in the period 12 – 16 June in Balatonboglár / HUN). The EHF Coaching team (P. Kovacs / EHF MC member – HUN, M. Petronijevic / EHF Lecturer – SRB and J. Boss / Mental Coach – GER) will be supported by A. Vock / Sport Scientist – AUT on 2 days of the workshop in order to educate the participants in the field periodization and structural set-up of training sessions. All participants will be asked to present 2 practical exercises in cooperation with the demonstration team (male and female handball players of the Hungarian National Academy for Handball). Feedback will be provided by the coaching team to all participants after each session and at the end of each day.

5.5. 2016 EHF Master Coach & Licensing Course – Preview / Licence Renewal Seminar

P. Kovacs informs on the 2nd module which will be organised in Szczyrk / POL in 18 – 25 June 2016. A respective invitation was already published in February 2016. The lecturers of the course are P. Kovacs / HUN – EHF MC member, A. Acsinte / ROU – EHF Lecturer, K. Feldmann / GER – EHF Lecturer, L. Michalsik / DEN – Sport Physiologist, B. Jelcic / CRO – Mental Coach as well as a National Lecturer from POL. The demonstration teams consist of the players of the Polish Junior National Team.

The 3rd module will be organised during the Women's EHF EURO in SWE in December 2016. Within the 3rd module course period an EHF Licence Renewal Seminar will be organised (16 hours).

Furthermore the absence of participants in one module was discussed. It is clearly stated by the MC that only major or sudden events can be a reason for excuse. National team coaches or assistant coaches can be excused for a period of max. 3 days of the module but only for events related to the National Team. A written seminar work has to be provided to EHF afterwards.

In addition H. Hörtsch informs on a “Master Coach platform” created by the course participants themselves sharing opinions, experiences and material.

6. Youth, School, and Non-competitive sports

6.1. “Basic Handball” / Handball at School – Task Force, Publications, Time-table

The website tool “Basic Handball Moves” will be realised as proposed in the 1st MC Meeting (video webtool and animated webtool – for details see minutes of 1st MC meeting). Further inputs will be provided by J. Anton Garcia until 10 May 2016. The final version shall be presented at the next MC meeting in September 2016.

6.2. Handball at School Conference POL – Preview

The basic data and programme (02 - 04 June 2016 in Kielce / POL) have been published via the EHF activities-website. C. Garcia / POR is nominated as EHF Lecturer. Currently 70 participants are registered for the conference – up to 200 expected.

6.3. Summer Camp POL – Preview

J. Eliaz reports on the planned Summer Camp dated 03 – 13 August 2016 in Gdansk. A detailed programme will be provided in due time.

6.4. Wheelchair Handball – EHF Working Group & Nations' Tournament / SWE

The invitation letter to the members of the EHF Working Group was sent. All members have confirmed their participation. As a first step all members will receive the recent "rules" as well as inputs regarding specifications for wheelchairs and classification for players from other Wheelchair Sports.

After receiving the feedback and input of all members a meeting will be held on 01/02 July 2016 in Vienna / AUT.

The final version of "How to play Wheelchair Handball", specifications for wheelchairs and classification for players shall be available late August.

6.5. Goalcha Cooperation

As an outcome of the activities realised during the EURO in POL in January 2016 "Goalcha" is already used and implemented by school / university teachers in POL.

Further Goalcha presentations will be held on the occasion of the 2016 EHF Master Coach & Licensing Course and the "Handball-at-School" Conference in Kielce / POL.

Furthermore the project was presented on the occasion of the Conference for Secretary General and was highly welcomed by the participants. As a result of the big interest further activities are foreseen in the upcoming EURO events and European Championships.

P. Sequeira outlines that "Goalcha" cannot only be used for kids but also for adults as a light version to play Handball.

6.6. EU Week of Sports

The 2016 EU Week of Sports is scheduled for the 10 – 17 September 2016. As in 2015 the EHF will support this initiative by motivating the Member Federations to carry-out promotional activities within the EU Week of Sports (European Open Day of Handball).

7. Development

7.1. 2016 EHF Secretary General Conference "Empowering Grassroots" Workshop

H. Hörtsch informs on the workshop "Empowering Grassroots" held on the occasion of the 2016 EHF Secretary Conference. The inputs of the participants (keeping young players in the sport, raising interest and awareness, reaching the players of tomorrow, ease the teaching of handball) were discussed by the MC also analysing possible ideas as attracting kids using Goalcha, etc.. The setting of concrete priorities shall be realised for the next working period.

Furthermore B. Kozłowska points out that some National Federations are not aware of the existing development programmes. More awareness will be created by the "step by step tool" (see agenda point 7.2.). In addition more MC / development related articles shall be published via the EHF website by presenting best-practice examples of current development programmes. The EHF Media Department will be approached accordingly.

7.2. Future strategies as of 2015 / 2016

A final version of the "Developing Handball in a country – a step by step tool" was provided by P. Sequeira. A brochure shall be created and distributed to the Member Federations.

7.3. SMART projects

The SMART programmes with MLT and ALB were signed. Further details have to be clarified with AND prior to a possible signing. The content of the programme was basically confirmed by the MC and accepted by the EXEC.

No feedback was received by MDA. A meeting could not be held on the occasion of the Secretary General Conference due to the late cancellation of the MDA representative's participation.

7.4. Foster projects

SCO informed on their interest in pro-longing the foster programme with ISL. The official request is expected in due time! Due to the successful first round of the foster programme the MC basically supports the continuation of the project following the usual guidelines (limited to 2 years, support with € 3.000,- for the emerging nation).

7.5. "Short-term" projects

16 Member Federations were supported with either lecturer nominations or material (mainly Beach Handball material) in 2016. In addition 7 ebt (European Beach Handball Tour) tournaments were supported with Beach Handball material (1 set of goals, 1 TV line-system, 40 Beach Handballs).

Due to the high number of requests for Beach Handball material (mainly for regional tournaments) it was discussed that material shall belong to the National Federations in order to enable the National Federations to lend the material to various organisers of national / regional tournaments. Furthermore detailed feedback on the outcome of the project / support shall be provided by the National Federation which can be published via the EHF channels (youtube, activities-website).

7.6. ISP projects

The ISP programmes (EHPU, ENG, IRL, MLT, SCO) are running according to the program and time-line agreed upon.

10. Club Manager Licence – blended learning programme 2016- Preview

17 participants have registered for the 5th edition of the Club Manger seminar organised in the period 26- 28 May 2016, in Cologne / GER on the occasion of the VELUX EHF Final 4. This edition will focus on the overall topic "Current and future Club / Federation Marketing Strategies".

11. University course "European Handball Manager" (Cologne)

16 participants have registered for the University course "European Handball Manager" (in English language). The deadline for the 2016 registration ends on 30 April 2016.

The awarding of the certificate for the participants of the 1st University course will be realised on 27 May 2016.

12. Scientific Platform

ESSKA (European Society of Sports Traumatology, Knee Surgery and Arthroscopy) will have a handball related Minisymposium on the occasion of their congress in May 2016 in Barcelona / ESP. M. Gillard is nominated by the EHF to participate in the congress.

13. EHF Lecturers as of 2017

A proposal for the EHF Coaching Lecturers shall be finalised in the next MC meeting dated 01 September 2016. Proposals for future EHF Lecturers shall be provided by the MC member by the end of June.

14. Any other business

14.1. Technical goal line during VELUX FINAL 4 in Cologne / GER

H. Hörtsch informs on the implementation of technical support (instant replay, goal line proof and goal light technology, etc.) to game administration on the occasion of the VELUX FINAL4 in Cologne / GER. It is outlined that those technical initiatives are only used to support the decision making for referees (upon their request) regarding situations that were not clearly observed by referees (due to the game situation) but will not overrule decisions made.

14.2. MC meeting 09/16

Due to the "EURO SWE Referees' and Delegates' Meeting" the 3rd MC meeting will be held on 01 September (arrival day 31 August, departure day 02 September).

14.3. Meeting of Senior National Coaches

P. Kovacs presents a concept for organising a "Meeting of Senior National Coaches". The aim is to learn the opinions (inputs, problems, initiatives, etc.) of National Coaches on the preparation for competitions and the competitions itself in order to revise the respective areas e.g. by adapting education, etc.. It is proposed to use the EHF Master Coach Courses to gather National Team coaches present to collect their ideas and inputs. The topics have to be clearly pre-defined. A detailed concept will be worked out by P. Kovacs and the EHF Office.

14.4. IHF Coaching and Methods Meeting

P. Kovacs reports on the IHF CCM Meeting in Basle / SUI. The main topic was the creation of an International Coaches Licensing System consisting of 4 levels (A: 150 hours of education, B: 90 hours of education, C: 60 hours of education and D: 30 hours of educations).


In order to strengthen Handball in big countries a first initiative is realised by establishing a Handball academy in China for the education of players and coaches with IHF Guest lecturers.
