### 1<sup>st</sup> Part – EHF Business

- 1. Welcome, programme, agenda
  - J. Eliasz welcomes the participants to the last meeting of the election period 2012 2016 and informs on N. Britt Husebo's absence due to other obligations.
- 2. MC Minutes 09/2016

The minutes are approved without any comments.

3. Coaching

The qualitative analysis of the EHF YAC EUROS M18 CRO, M20 DEN and the EHF YAC Championships M18 BUL, M18 LTU have not been finalised yet. The MC outlines that all analyses have to be finalised and published by the end of the year.

#### 4. Education and Training

RINCK Convention – New Members: GEO and UKR are both interested in becoming RINCK Convention Signatories. Further contact shall be established on the occasion of the EHF Congress. No further information has been received from BIH and KOS. Personal contact shall be established on the occasion of the EHF Congress.

National Master Coach courses: Details (programme, participants list, etc.) have been received from DEN. New course cycles are planned in Hungary (2018) and POL (2017).

The EHF RINCK Convention Seminar shall be held on 09 / 10 February in Vienna / AUT (one representative per RICNK Convention Signatory).

MKD: Personal talks shall be held with MKD regarding the acceptance of Master Coach Status.

P. Kovacs informs on the status of the  $3^{rd}$  module of the 2016 EHF Master Coach & Licensing Course held in the period 09-16 December 2016. 52 participants will attend the  $3^{rd}$  module. Parallel an EHF "Top Coaches' and License Renewal Seminar" is going to be organised at the end of the 3rd module in the period 13-16 December 2016. 14 registrations have been received for the renewal seminar.

On request by some Member Federations the EHF MC proposes a transition period until 2017 for Pro-Licence holders (expiring end of 2016). However a renewal course has to be attended in 2017.

Young Coaches Workshop: The next edition of the EHF Young Coaches Workshop shall be held on 02 July (arrival date) and 06 July (departure date) in Szczyrk / POL. However further details and costs have to be clarified with the Polish Handball Federation.

#### 5. Youth, School and Non-Competitive Sports

The EHF periodical article "Handball at School" by EHF MC Member Juan Anton Garcia was published. An e-book version will be published after clarification of some technical details.

### 6. Development

The SMART programme with ARM was confirmed by the EXEC. The SMART programmes with LUX, MDA and SRB as well as the Foster programme ALB-SCO will be signed on the occasion of the EHF Congress.

The "Develop handball in your country – A step by step guide" based on the document by P. Sequeira / MC – Development has been printed and shall be handed out to the participants of the Congress.
