Minutes:

1. Welcome / Agenda / Basics

J. Eliaz welcomes the participants to the 3rd MC meeting 2018 and informs that S. Röttger cannot participate in the meeting due to some private reasons.

2. MC Minutes and other minutes (MC related topics)

The MC notes are approved without any comments.

3. Methods & Coaching

3.1. Analyses 2018- M20 EURO in SLO, M18 EURO in CRO, M20 Championship in MKD, M20 Championship in MNE, M18 Championship in AUT, M18 Championship in GEO

The quantitative analysis of the M20 EURO in SLO and M18 EURO in CRO prepared by T. Szydłowski has been provided. P.Kovacs prepared and provided the M18 Ch MKD qualitative/trend analysis. All documents will be published online via activities.eurohandball.com.

The nominated specialists carried-out the analyses on site and shall provide the written documents within the given deadline of 4-6 weeks after the end of the event.

P. Kovacs is nominated for the qualitative/trend analysis of the 2018 Women's EURO in FRA in December.

3.2. YAC Injury Analysis 2018

M. Gillard prepared an injury analysis of the M20 EURO in SLO based on the forms provided by the Teams' Officials. An injury report form the M18 EURO in CRO will be prepared by the end of September. The final documents will be distributed to all teams participating in the events. For the future, in order to prepare more complex analysis, more detailed information from the teams will be required.

4. Education and Training

4.1. RINCK Convention- Signatories/ Non-Signatories status

KOS and BIH joined the EHF RINCK Convention and signed the respective documents at the EHF Congress in Glasgow/SCO. No annual activity report has been provided by the newcomers so far.

The nations, whose documents were missing, sent the annual activity reports 2018 after D. Simion and J. Eliaz contacted the representatives from those countries officially on behalf of the EHF.

The non-signatory countries have been invited to an informal meeting during the EHF Congress in Glasgow to discuss the situation and plan further steps in this direction.

A proposal for a "Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) cooperation" between emerging non-signatories with neighbouring signatories has been made by D. Simion and P. Sequeira. Discussions between ALB & ITA, AZE & TUR, UKR & BLR and GEO regarding the improvement in this topic are ongoing.

Due to some language problems the communication with UKR is difficult. Therefore, UKR shall provide proper information in their language and the EHF will translate it into English.

4.2. National & EHF Master Coach Courses (3rd Module 2018)

D. Simion, P. Sequeira, S. Röttger and M. Bon made a proposal for Master Coach Course core topics to be implemented in EHF Master Coach Courses. The outcome will be presented during the next EHF RINCK Convention Seminar to take it into consideration. The EHF MC Members should participate in the EHF RINCK Convention Seminar to bring some inputs from the development perspective. An expert

from UEFA shall be invited to the seminar as well to discuss the best possible solutions regarding coaching education based on the experience from football.

An update in the overall structure of the EHF Master Coach Courses is necessary and will be done.
H. Höritsch proposes to create a panel which will be dealing with Master Coach Courses-related topics.

D. Simion informs about a coaches- related problem the clubs are dealing with more and more often. The coaches are leaving the clubs and break the contracts without any consequences causing trouble for the club during the season. The MC proposal is not to accept the Coaching License of such a coach at the next club he is moving to based on the "1 licensed coach on the bench" rule.

P. Kovacs reports on the 2nd Module of the EHF Master Coach Course in Győr / HUN, from 11 - 17 June 2018. Respective reports have been provided to the EHF MC. The 3rd Module is planned for 10-16 December 2018 and will take place in Créteil/FRA. The Licence Renewal Course will take place parallel to the 3rd Module as well. Participating coaches will visit the semi-final matches of the EHF Women's EURO. A draft of the Programme has been made.

4.3. 2020 Coaches Licensing- Communication

The information about the Coaches Licensing will be given to the clubs during the upcoming Champions League Workshop.

The reminder regarding this topic will be sent to the National Federations.

5. Youth, School, and Non-competitive sports

5.1. Young Coaches Workshop- preview

The 2019 Young Coaches Workshop will be organized in Szczyrk/POL. The event will take place in the 1st half of June 2019. J. Eliaz will make a proposal about the exact date within the next months.

5.2. Summer Camp- review

The Summer Camp took place from 02-12 August 2018 in Gdansk/POL. 118 participants (96 boys born 2002 and 2003 & 14 coaches plus 22 boys from Danish Team Kobenhavn Handbold) were divided into 7 groups. Each group had two (90-120min) practical sessions per day plus one extra goalkeeper training. Three types of training were planned: gymnastics combined with individual technique, overall agility, track and field specialized handball training. Apart from the activities mentioned above, all groups played test games (between themselves). The feedback from the event was very positive. Reports from both, the EHF Lecturer W. Pollany/AUT and the Local Organizer (PHF) have been provided.

Parallel to the Summer Camp, on 8. August 2018, a Conference for youth team coaches has been organized.

5.3. EU Week of Sport

Event Info 1 and Info 2 have been sent to all National Federations. The Info 3 is foreseen to be sent next week. The concept of the activity stays the same like in the previous year. A new e-mail address has been announced, so that the National Federations can send their input/ questions/ ideas directly to the organizer.

5.4. Wheelchair Handball

- 2018 European Wheelchair Handball Nations' Tournament in POR- preview

Information on the tournament in Leiria/POR from 30 November to 2 December 2018 has been distributed to all National Federations. 4 Teams (HUN, NED, POR, SWE) have already provided their registration forms.

An official information about the current situation shall be sent to the LOC.

5.5. Grassroots Market Place

The Grassroots Market activities will be organized in two days. On Friday, 14 December the presentations prepared by the WHB will take place, on the 15 December 8 presentations will be offered in a parallel session (2 rooms). Besides, a practical presentation about the project "Share &

Play”, a demonstration Wheelchair Handball Match, and a Goalcha stand will be included in the programme. The FRA National Federation will confirm the rundown within the next week.

6. Development

6.1. SMART programme

- SCO: The first phase is finished and the report was submitted and distributed.
- LUX: The second phase is finished and the report was submitted and distributed.
- ALB: For the third phase the support for coaches was requested now.
- EST: The third phase ended and the final report was submitted and distributed. A request including the needed documents for a new SMART programme was sent in July. The proposal to start a new SMART programme was confirmed by the Methods Commission under the precondition to stay within the defined budget.
- BEL: The third phase ended and the final report was submitted and distributed. An overall and final SMART programme report will be requested by the Federation.

6.2. Short term support

34 national short term requests were received until now. The main requests were concerning the nomination of EHF lecturers.

A new request for beach handball material was sent by CYP in August. This request was confirmed by the MC.

7. CAN Activities

Hörtsch provides a status report on the main ongoing topics of the EHF Technical Delegation/CAN Advisory Board meeting such as Technology Support in Handball, EHF opinion poll on Rules of the Game and an e-learning and testing platform for EHF delegates. There is a clear MC opinion in favour of coaches using technologies like I-pads, tablets during the match with details to be defined.

8. “Handball 4 Dual Career” and “Onside” Erasmus+ Projects

The 5th “Handball 4 Dual Career” Partner Meeting is planned for the final weekend at the 2018 EHF Women’s EURO in FRA, including a presentation in the framework of the EHF “Grassroot Market Place”.

On 26/27 July the 2nd “Onside” Partner Meeting was carried-out in Papendal/NED. The EHF provided substantial input regarding EHF Referee and Delegate education and further training.

9. Medical Research Centre/LUX

The EHF received a proposal by Dr. Romain Seil (EHF Scientific Network Member) concerning a Medical Research Centre Project in LUX with a proposal to cooperate with the EHF. Since it is the 1st information on the project, the MC, after commenting on several aspects, will further deal with the matter before any kind of recommendation to the EXEC.

10. EHF Scientific Conference 2019

The date and venue of the Conference have to be defined, if possible- within the time of the National Team week in order to involve some coaches in the event. The conference should be longer than the previous one (starting on Friday in the afternoon, finishing on Sunday morning- date 25-27. October to be checked). Since it will be the 5th edition of the event, it shall be bigger to compare with the previous ones.

The topic of the conference shall link the coaches, scientific people and medical aspects of handball. H. Hörtsch proposes to invite a group of experts from other sport disciplines to exchange the experience and to include in the programme some practical presentations. A cooperation with the International Council for Coaching Excellence (ICCE) is foreseen.

- For the 1st time a legal case has been opened against the CRO club GRK Varazdin 1930 for not having a licensed coach during the EHF Cup competition during the whole season.
- Injury prevention video prepared by the PHF is being prepared. After adding the English subtitles the material will be published on the EHF website.
- In case of an EHF Lecturer's nomination an insurance agreement has to be activated by the EHF.
- With reference to the respective EHF 2018 Congress decision, H. Höritsch reports on the meeting with Handball Specials/AUT- a group dealing with handball events for mentally handicapped people. Further actions to be defined in due time.
