1. Welcome and Introduction

President Wiederer opened the meeting with welcoming words to all participants and explaining the role of the chairmen representing the NCM. Furthermore, the possible nomination of the elected people into the different boards was described.

2. Status Report EHF Competitions

5. Election of Chairperson

Chat between the participants took place about the experience of the previous members and how the elected person should represent the Committee. Following the common discussion the NCM Members elected Ingo Meckes as a Chairperson of the NCM.



6. Election of Vice-Chairperson

Following the common discussion the NCM Members elected Jari Henttonen as a Vice-Chairperson of the NCM.

7. Miscellaneous

A question regarding the registration procedure for the M19 EHF EURO and all YAC Summer Events 2022 was raised.

The participants also discussed the issue of a possible late ending of the national leagues and what options the EHF has in order to be able to finish the registration process in time. This point will be forwarded to the PHB in order to clarify the options with the leagues.

Fintan Lyons asked about the latest status of the IHF/EHF Trophy 2021 and if there are reasons why nations did or did not register for the Trophy. After the information exchange it was agreed that he will discuss with some nations why they did not register as he is interested in gathering more data about a non-registration in order to understand the difficulties and to work on a solution for this.
